Dear Parents,

HELICOPTER

As you know our planned helicopter visit in Week 1 of this term was postponed due to the terrible weather at the time. The visit was rescheduled to

this Friday and we have our fingers crossed for great weather to enable this exciting event to take place.

We have spent a lot of time planning and liaising with the navy to ensure that strict safety procedures are in place for the visit and to ensure that all our students get the maximum benefit from the experience. The students will watch the landing and take-off from the walkways and balconies of the classroom block, or inside the classrooms if particularly sensitive to noise. Once the helicopter has landed and completely shut down the students will be able to approach to within a designated safe distance and will be given a talk by the navy personnel. The students will then return to their viewing areas for the departure of the helicopter.
