Principal's Message

Dear Parents,

School Surveys

Thank you everyone who has taken the time to complete our two recent surveys regarding our enrichment programs and uniform. Stop Work Meeting

I have been advised that the NSW Teachers Federation has called a stop work meeting for teachers on Tuesday 3rd December from 9-11am. This will impact on our school with the majority of staff attending the meeting. The school will be open on Tuesday and minimal supervision will be provided for students who are present.

Scarlet Fever

We have had reports of two cases of scarlet fever at school recently. Scarlet fever is an illness that sometimes occurs when your child gets a bacterial throat infection. Below is an extract from the NSW Health fact sheet on Infectious Diseases of Childhood:

<u>Scarlet Fever</u>

Time from exposure to illness: 1 to 3 days.

Symptoms: Sudden onset sore throat, high fever and vomiting, followed by a rash in 12 to 36 hours.

<u>Do I need to keep my child home?</u> Yes, until at least 24 hours of treatment has begun and the child is feeling better.

How can I prevent spread? Careful hand washing. If you are sick see your doctor.
