#### Last Day, 2016

Friday 16 December will be the last day of school for students and teachers. Teaching staff undertook additional professional learning after school during the course of the year as an alternative to the two designated days at the end of the year.

#### Day 1, 2017

On Monday 30 January, next year, students will arrive at school and assemble in the morning with their 2016 class teachers. Once student enrolment numbers are finalised, students will then move into their 2017 classes. While it is important to arrive at school for the start of term, if your child will be delayed in returning to school please notify the office this year. Uncertainty around student enrolments can delay, or significantly impact, the organisation of classes.

#### The Flat: Astro Turf

The school has been supported by the Department's Asset Management Unit (AMU) in the planning and contracting for a new synthetic playing surface on *The Flat*. With works scheduled to be undertaken during the school holidays, the project should be nearing completion (or completed) when students return in 2017. Families accessing vacation care over January should avoid the top entrance and car park where heavy machinery will be accessing the site.
